2020 On-line classes

- Class 3 A painting of a big red bus. Open to children aged 8 and under on 31st August 2020.
- Class 4 A photograph "A Means of Transport". Open to children aged 9-15 on 31st August 2020.

2020 On-line Show awards

- Winner of Class 1 will be awarded the Bolton Cup
- Winner of Class 2 will be awarded the Henry Dyke Memorial Challenge Cup
- Winner of Class 3 will be awarded the Shorthouse Cup
- Winner of Class 4 will be awarded the Owen Challenge Cup

No other cups will be awarded in 2020

2020 On-line Show entry rules

- Entry is open to residents in the Parish of Old Basing & Lychpit and there is no entry charge for any of the classes.
- Photographs must be taken during July or August 2020 and, for 2020 only, must be submitted electronically. For all classes, photos should be emailed as an attachment to contact@oblvs.org.uk.
- Classes 1 and 2 One entry is permitted per class per household.
- Class 3 One entry per Child. Paintings should be scanned or digitally photographed and emailed as an attachment to contact@oblvs.org.uk. Parents/guardians can assist in the scanning and delivery of the email.
- Class 4 One entry per Child. Photos should be emailed as an attachment to contact@oblvs.org.uk. Parents/guardians can assist in the delivery of the email.

- Emails must include entrant's name and address and, for classes 3 and 4, the child's age. **Our information retention policy can be found in the note below.**
- Entries must be submitted by **midnight on 31st August 2020**.
- All classes will be judged by the committee during early September and winners will be notified by email. For 2020 only, the entries will be judged from the photographs and there will be no site visits.
- All entries will be posted, after judging, on the Gallery page of the OBVLS
 web site. Please indicate in your email if you wish your name/child's name
 to be added as a caption to your photograph on our web site. No entrant
 addresses will be published.
